 - **Replace** with May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011.

Question:

1. Would a bid be considered or rejected if the bid did not include Bed Bugs, under Scope of work as it is currently written? Could you submit your bid and separate Bed Bugs out as an additional service and fees such as birds and termites?

Under Section 1, Administrative Overview, Item VII. F. Exceptions, page 5
