OPENING OF STATE-AIDED ELDERLY PUBLIC HOUSING WAITING LIST

November 07, 2023 – November 09, 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) in accordance with Chapter 15-186, State-Aided Elderly Public Housing Projects, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), outlined by the Hawaii Public Housing Authority, will temporarily reopen the waiting list for applicants for studios and one bedroom apartments.

The State Elderly Public Housing geographic waiting lists available to apply for are:

- Urban Honolulu (Hale Po'ai or Halia Hale)
- Central Oahu/Wahiawa (Laiola)
- Central Oahu/Waipahu (Kamalu - Ho'olulu)

Applications will be available for pick up between 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. on,

**Completed applications must be returned to the Management Office by
Tuesday, November 21, 2023 by 4:00 p.m.**

What is State-Aided Elderly Housing: State-Aided Elderly Public Housing is a program that provides housing for very low-income families. There are no preferences for applicants applying for the following program. To apply the Head of household or Co-head must be 62 years of age and a resident of the State of Hawaii.

The family's portion of the rent is based on household income and tenant shall pay 30 percent of adjusted annual income for rent or a minimum rent of \$170 for a 0-bedroom and \$195 for a one-bedroom, whichever is greater. Your gross household income must be less than the amounts listed in the chart below.

How do I apply?

Applications must be picked up and submitted to the management offices, located at **94-941 Kauolu Place, Office A107, Waipahu, Hawaii 96797 or 1001 North School Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96817.**

Management Staff will acknowledge receipt of your application by date and time-stamped. No applications will be accepted at the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's Administrative Office. Please, no phone or fax calls.

1. **Be prepared** by having the names, dates of birth, and Social Security Numbers available for all persons who will be listed on your pre-application. You will need to know your total yearly gross income (before taxes) for all persons listed on your pre-application. You must list all the amounts together as one dollar amount.
2. **Submit a completed application by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 21, 2023.** Applications submitted after this time and date will be rejected. Applications not fully completed (i.e., in the middle of submission) prior to the closing will be rejected.

Do not submit more than one application. Duplicate applications do not increase your chances of placement into public housing.

The public is reminded that there is no charge to apply. Applicants are encouraged to immediately report any individual or organization who attempts to charge a fee for completion of the application process.

Within approximately 30 days of the waiting list closure, applicants will be receive a notice if they were placed on the State-Aided Elderly Public Housing waiting list or not. Please do not call the management office prior to receiving this letter as no information will be given over the phone regarding your application.

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
