SUBJECT: Invitation for Bids No. PMB-2021-09, Addendum No. 2
Furnish and Deliver New Maintenance Vehicles to the Hawaii Public
Housing Authority on Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii Island

This Addendum No. 2 is to: 1) amend the IFB; and 2) provide responses to questions that were received at the Pre-Bid Tele-Conference conducted by the Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) on March 5, 2021, up until March 12, 2021:

Part I – Amendments

1. **Amend** Section 2, subsection II.L. Single or Multi-Term Contracts to be Awarded, page 15, as follows:

Flatbed Trucks:

Initial term of contract: Up to 210 Calendar Days

Length of each extension: Up to 60 Calendar Days

Maximum length of contract: 280 Calendar Days

The initial Contract period shall upon issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

2. **Amend** Section 2.III.B.1.a.Type – New Flatbed Truck, iii.Engine, page 22 by adding the following:

“The furnished vehicles must be designed to operate on diesel. Vehicles designed to operate on gas only will not be accepted.”

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3. **Amend** Section 2.III.B.1.a.Type – New Flatbed Truck, xi.Exterior, page 22 by adding the following

v. Body/Cab: Cab with 2 Doors, 12 Foot **Steel Bed**
GVWR 18,000 – 25,000

4. **Amend** Section 2.III.B.1.a.Type – New Flatbed Truck, xi.Exterior, page 22 and 23 by adding the following:

xi. Exterior: Color: Factory White or Silver (White Preferred)
Dual Outside Mirrors
Factory Tinted Glass; All Windows
Auto Headlamps
Rear and Brake Lamps
Windshield Wipers with Variable Speed
Stake Bed Body with Tread Plate Platform Floor
Tie Down Rings, **Inside Bed**
Standard Removeable Galvanneal Steel Racks **Stakes with Aluminum Slats**; size – 36"
~~Swing Open Gate for Access on One Side~~
Lift Gate at Rear (**type – railgate; weight capacity – 1600lbs; 1-piece treadplate steel w/42" loading depth + 6" taper; even with 36" stake sides**)

5. **Amend** Section 2.III.B.1.b.Type – New Mid Size Sport Utility Vehicle, iii.Engine, page 23 as follows:

iii. Engine: ~~3.5 Liter~~ **3.6 Liter**
Six (6) Cylinder (**V6**)

6. **Amend** Section 2.III.B.1.b.Type – New Mid Size Sport Utility Vehicle, iv.Transmission, page 24 as follows:

iv. Transmission: Six (6) Speed Automatic with ~~Four (4)~~ **4x4**
Wheel Drive Capability

7. **Replace** Attachment 1 – Bid Offer Form with Attachment 1a – Bid Offer Form (rev. 3/12/21). Offerors shall submit bid offers using Attachment 1a – Bid Offer Form (rev. 3/12/21) to be considered responsive. Bid offers submitted using Attachment 1 shall be rejected and deemed non-responsive.

Part II – Written Questions and Responses:

1. Will diesel fuel trucks be accepted? Our dealership deals with specifically diesel fuel trucks that require DEF(diesel emission fluid) fluid and have Diesel Particulate Filter systems that require timely Re-generation when prompted.

Response:

Yes, diesel fuel trucks will be accepted. See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB.

2. Also with delays in manufacturing throughout all the Covid restrictions, the manufacturing and body upfitting and delivery would make it impossible to meet the 90 day requirement. Most all manufacturers are all backed up with either orders or procurement of materials right now due to previous covid restrictions and/or lockdowns. I am concerned more so with the body manufacturers(flatbed) meeting the timeline once they get our truck chassis. Would it be possible to get the delivery timeline extended to 150 days from time of receiving award and the notice to proceed? With the option of extension for another 30-60 days if needed?

Response:

The HPHA has considered amending the timeline for the delivery of the new flatbed trucks. See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB.

3. Lastly, what is the type/style or example of the liftgate desired on the flatbed trucks and the weight capacity you're looking for?

Response:

See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB for additional information on the liftgate requirements for the new flatbed trucks.

4. Looking at the Mid Size Sport Utility specs for IFB PMB-2021-09, just want to confirm and verify that on letter B for transmission it states: Six 6) speed automatic with four (4) wheel drive... Does this mean they want a 4x4 or All Wheel Drive?

Response:

The HPHA is intending to procure a mid size sport utility vehicle that is a 4x4 drive. See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB.

5. Gas or diesel?

Response:

New Flat Bed Trucks must be designed to operate on diesel. See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB.

6. On the Liftgate what you will be lifting and what would be the maximum weight?

Response:

The flatbed trucks will be used to haul appliances such as refrigerators and ranges, furniture and miscellaneous bulky items. The maximum capacity for the liftgate is 1600 lbs. See Part I of this Addendum No. 1 for amendments to this IFB.
