PROJECT DESCRIPTION The Community Resource Center at Kuhio Park Terrace/ Kuhio Homes, in Honolulu, Hawaii will be a one-stop, multi-purpose community center for the residents of Kuhio Homes (KH) and Kuhio Park Terrace (KPT) public housing, other nearby public housing residents and the Kalihi community.

A primary objective of the Community Resource Center is to enable the residents and community members to transition out of low income housing, off welfare dependency and into the larger community of self-sufficiency and employment.

The proposed center will provide a nucleus for community identity and activities, which will enrich the community socially, culturally, educationally, occupationally and economically.

The resource center will include a Main Building of 48,485 SF and a Pavilion (Fale) of 1,262 SF.
